## COME JOIN THE FUN!!



**ST. THOMAS MORE:** Saint, knight, Lord Chancellor of England, author and martyr, born in London, 7 February, 1477-78; executed at Tower Hill, 6 July, 1535.

More was a diligent writer with a few of his works remaining in manuscript until some years after his death. Several of his writings have been lost altogether. Of all his writings the most famous is unquestionably the **Utopia**, first published at Louvain in 1516. The volume recounts the fictitious travels of one **Raphael Hythlodaye**, a mythical character, who, in the course of a voyage to America, was left behind near Cape Frio where he wandered on until he chanced upon the Island of Utopia ("nowhere") in which he found an ideal constitution in operation. The whole work is really an exercise of the imagination with brilliant satire upon the world of More's own day.
