**RULE CHANGE FOR WEDDING LITURGIES:** In the past, the pastor could give permission for a wedding between a Catholic and baptized non-Catholic to take place during Mass. That “faculty” of the pastor has been revoked effective immediately. The letter from the Archbishop states: “Priests who wish to have a Mass for a wedding in which one of the parties is a baptized non-Catholic must seek permission from the Archbishop’s Office. This permission will be granted only when the baptized non-Catholic party is able to receive Holy Communion at the Mass. The conditions for a baptized non-Catholic receiving Holy Communion according to Church law are: that a person have a Eucharistic faith that is in accord with that of the Church; that the person experience a real spiritual need for Eucharistic sustenance; that the person is unable to have recourse to his or her own minister for the sacrament of the Eucharist; that the person asks for the sacrament of his or her own accord. It is the diocesan bishop’s responsibility to examine these exceptional cases and make concrete decisions.” In other words, weddings with a Mass, for all practical purposes, are now limited to weddings between two baptized Catholic parties only.
